**Scholarships

- A. Maybe awarded to one or more eligible recipients, at the discretion of the *Richard Edwards Memorial Ministerial Scholarship Team*, and in the amounts determined solely by the Scholarship Team.
- B. Shall be awarded on a one-year basis.
 1. Applicants must submit an application each school year in order to be considered for a scholarship.
 2. Applicants may only receive consideration for a scholarship for a maximum of five (5) school years (Fall and Spring Semester/Quarters), but need not be consecutive years.
