He served as pastor of three different churches, the last one being Bonnie Donne Baptist, where he served until he accepted the call as *Superintendent of Missions* for the New South River Baptist Association. During his twenty-eight (28) years of faithful dedicated service to NSRBA he was known for a generous heart that could not say no and a desire to please all. He was tragically killed in a car accident six (6) weeks following his retirement from NSRBA.
